

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
UNITED STATES CAPITOL PAGE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, INC.**

To:
Department of consumer and Regulatory Affairs

We, the undersigned persons of the age of eighteen years or more, acting as Incorporators of a corporation under the NON-PROFIT CORPORATION ACT (D.C. Code, 2001 edition, Title 29, Chapter 3), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is: United States Capitol Page Alumni Association, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: To promote the page program in the Congress and the Supreme Court; provide educational assistance to capitol pages in need of aid; to provide educational programs for the public and capitol pages; and general welfare.

FOURTH: The corporation shall have members. The members of the corporation shall be persons who have been a page, during high school years, in one of the following institutions or subsidiary institutions thereof, e.g. document page, folding room or other, in the United States Senate, United States House of Representatives, or United States Supreme Court. The members shall not have voting rights.

FIFTH: The manner in which the Directors shall be elected or appointed shall be provided in the bylaws.

SIXTH: The provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation shall be provided in the bylaws. Upon dissolution or final liquidation of the corporation, assets of the corporation shall be dispensed to charity.
